Welcome to the November P7M Class Newsletter!

Interdisciplinary Learning

P7M have thoroughly enjoyed the 'World of Work' topic and have gained a lot of knowledge from a wide range of professionals. All children were able to remember key points from each presentation and completed an extensive amount of written work based on their learning which will be shared with you at our upcoming assembly on 24th November 2017. The children were also able to identify the skills they had further developed during this topic.

Numeracy and Maths

P7M completed assessments based on decimals. The children have started to recognise the importance of revision and using tools to assist learning in order to improve. The children have also completed weekly Big Maths Beat That and CLIC tests to improve numeracy skills. Regular practise of LearnIts help to increase scores. A variety of our World of Work visitors also incorporated maths into their presentations referring to budgets and asking the children to solve problems. For example, the Civil Engineer asked the children to make a stable structure from dried spaghetti and midget gems using triangles.

Literacy

As noted above, the children have completed a huge amount of written work based on our World of Work topic. In addition to this, they organised the information logically in a poster to portray their learning.

The children continued to be inspired by author Ciaran Murtagh and used a dictionary page to create a title and then write a story based around this title.

P7M continue to read Divided City as a class novel and demonstrate their understanding by completing a range of comprehension tasks.
