

## Behaviour Log

This is used throughout the school P1-7 to log and monitor pupil behaviour.

It is monitored by the Senior Leadership Team and a new log sheet is started termly allowing children to have a fresh start.

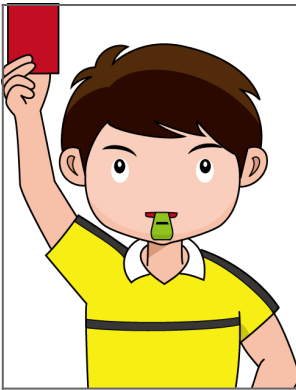
Pupils' names are put into the Behaviour Log if they receive a Red Ticket in the playground or have reached Red on the Traffic Lights in class.

If pupils continue to misbehave after a Red Ticket/Traffic Light in any one day, they will receive a Blue Ticket.

Two Red Tickets/Traffic Lights or one Blue Ticket in one week will result in the loss of the next planned special privilege e.g. excursions, parties, visitors.

A child with a Blue Ticket will skip a step in the Behaviour Log. Their parent/carer will be contacted to attend a meeting to draft a behaviour contract.

The Behaviour Log will be consulted with regard to children attending our P7 Residential Trip.



## Behaviour Log Consequences

**Step 1-**Logged

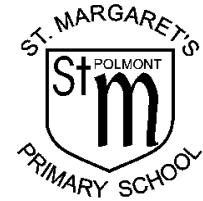
**Step 2-**Stop and Think Exercise sent home. To be returned the next day. No return and child stays in at break to complete.

**Step 3-** Class teacher telephones parents/carers and Rights Respecting Schools' Exercise sent home. To be returned the next day. No return and child stays in at break to complete

**Step 4-**Class teacher sends a letter home to be returned the next day. Reflection Time is given for 2 breaks.

**Step 5-** Class teacher sends another letter home and Reflection Time is given for 4 breaks

**Step 6-** Head Teacher or Depute Head Teacher meets with parents. Reflection Time is given for 1 week.
