

Celebrate and Reward

Our HMIe report (March 2013) and our recent authority validation report found our children to be polite, articulate and well-mannered. HMIe highlighted this as a key strength. We want to celebrate and reward this positive behaviour.



Class Charters:

These are created with the children at the start of the session and are linked to the Rights of the Child. Each class may operate their own additional reward systems to promote positive behaviour.

House System:

St. Margaret's P.S. and Nursery Class operates a House System for all children P1-7 to reward and encourage positive behaviour. The houses are:

- Arran
- Islay
- Mull
- Skye



House Points

House Points are awarded for:

- Upholding the school's vision and ethos
- Star Pupil Awards
- Out of School Achievements
- Golden Tickets
- Respecting the rights of other children
- Homework completed and handed in on time.

House Rewards

Points will be collected by the P7 House Captains each week and announced at weekly assemblies.

Those children who have stayed off Red and Blue Tickets in the Winning House will be rewarded with an extra playtime once a month.

Children who have stayed on green, or who have had a maximum of one Red Ticket/Red Traffic Light per term in the winning house, will receive a House Reward at the end of the school session.

Traffic Lights

All children begin each day on a Green Traffic Light. Those who stay on green will be awarded House Points.

Children who prevent themselves or others from achieving their rights:

- are given a warning-a chance to stop and think about their behaviour before moving to Amber and another warning before reaching Red
- If a child reaches Red they will lose 5 minutes of Golden Time that week and be logged in the Behaviour Log. If they continue to disrespect the school/class charter they will lose another 5 minutes of Golden Time.



Playground Behaviour

Support Staff award children Golden Tickets for respecting the rights of others and Red Tickets for those who prevent others from achieving their rights.



Golden Tickets

Children will be awarded 10 House points for a Golden Ticket and these tickets are put into the Golden Time Raffle Box.

The children who have stayed off Red in the class with the highest amount of Golden Tickets each month will receive 10 minutes extra playtime.



Golden Time

30mins of free activity. This is provided weekly for P1-7 children.
